Bipolar Disorder affects 1 in 50 Australians



CRAIG HAMILTON

Professional Motivational Speaker, Author of *Broken Open*, father and sportsman. On the eve of the biggest undertaking of his career as an ABC Journalist, Craig was hospitalised for 2 weeks after suffering a psychotic episode at a Newcastle Railway station and later diagnosed with Bipolar 1 disorder.

Born and raised in the Hunter Valley, Craig spent 16 years working as an underground coalminer in the Newcastle area before embarking on a radio career for ABC radio as 'the sideline eye' on weekend Rugby League broadcasts. Later he was calling Grand Finals, State of Origin Games and Test Matches involving Australia.

Today he works tirelessly as an advocate for mental health issues, speaking at numerous conferences across the country and lobbying for extra funding to support people and their families who have experienced depressive illnesses. By sharing his story and experience Craig Hamilton offers hope to others.

Schizophrenia affects 1 in 100 Australians

Dr Karve is a practicing dentist specialising in treating patients with bipolar disorder and schizophrenia. She will review the associated problems with treating patients who suffer from mental illnesses and highlight major dental concerns such as occlusal problems, patient compliance, and pharmaceutical complications.

Dr Karve will share her knowledge and experience so that all dental hygienists, dentists and dental auxiliaries may have a solid foundation to care for their own patients better.
